

Connecting Personal Android Devices to Cuesta's Eduroam Wi-Fi Network

Eduroam is a worldwide network of research and education institutions that broadcast the eduroam wireless network.

If a wireless device is properly configured for eduroam it will automatically connect at any participating institution. Cal Poly is the closest participating institution, to search for others visit the [eduroam U.S. Connectors website](#).

Please note: Not all Android setting present the same. WIFI settings can be different from device to device depending on what manufactures and service providers have changed.

To set up your device (smart phone, tablet, etc.) to automatically connect to Cuesta's wireless access:

1. Tap **Apps** in the upper-right corner, then select **Settings** and click on **Wireless & networks**.

- a. Verify Wi-Fi is checked and click on **Wi-Fi settings**.

2. Tap on **eduroam**.

3. Complete the following:

- a. EAP method = PEAP
- b. Phase 2 Authentication = MSCHAPV2
- c. CA Certificate =
 - i. Option 1 -Do not validate
 - ii. Option 2 - Use system certificates or leave unspecified

(Picture at right shows Option 1.)

- d. Domain = **cuesta.edu**
Note: You will only need to complete the Domain if you chose Option 2 above.
- e. Minimum TLS version = TLS v1.0
- f. Online Certificate Status = Do Not Verify
- g. Identity = your Cuesta email address
- h. Anonymous Identity = leave blank
Or, if you are having trouble enter your Cuesta email address.
- i. Password = your Cuesta password

4. Tap Save/Connect/OK
