<p><b>* PRIORITY 1: VETERANS/FOSTER YOUTH/CALWORKS/DSPTS/EOPS/HOMELESS YOUTH</b> Eligible students in these programs:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Armed Forces of the United States</b>, member or former member who is a resident of California, received an honorable discharge, a general discharge, or an other than honorable discharge, and any member or former member of the State Military Reserve, for any academic term attended at a CSU, UC or CCC, for four academic years after he/she has left state or federal active duty, which he/she shall use within 15 years of leaving state/federal active duty;</li> <li>• <b>Foster Youth</b> and emancipated foster youth up to, and including, the age of 24.
