The review process required by this section shall include the review and comments by the local Private Industry Council established pursuant to Division 8 (commencing with Section 15000) of the Unemployment Insurance Code, which review and comments shall occur prior to any decision by the appropriate governing body.
- C. This section shall apply to each program commenced subsequent to July 28, 1983.
- D. A written summary of the findings of each review shall be made available to the public.
